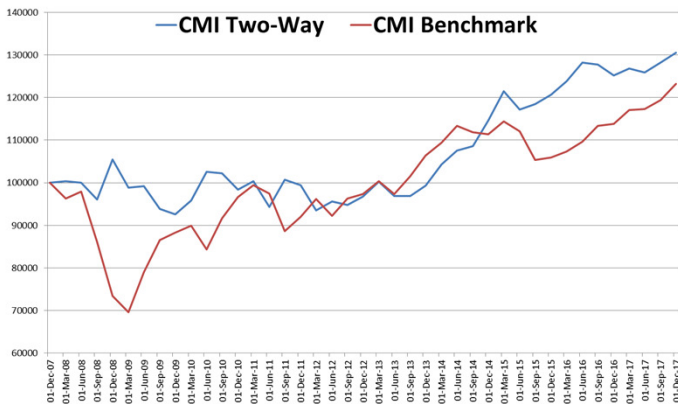
What are the Risks?

- This portfolio is appropriate for sophisticated and experienced investors only and is normally limited to 20% of total portfolio assets.

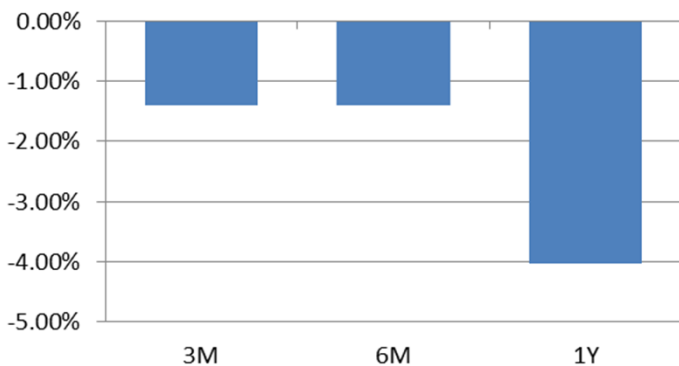
